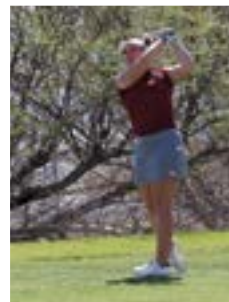

Rural Opportunities

Rural Health Opportunities Program (RHOP)

RHOP is a cooperative program between CSC and the University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC). Students receive a tuition waiver at CSC and receive guaranteed admission to UNMC after completing the RHOP program requirements. Learn more about the program and requirements at csc.edu/rhop.

Tuition Guarantee

The state college Tuition Guarantee ensures that all new freshmen and transfer students who are Pell-eligible can attend Chadron State College tuition free. Qualifying students will receive a combination of federal and state grants, as well as institutional scholarships to fill any tuition gap left after the Pell Grant. The Tuition Guarantee is renewable for up to four years by meeting the renewal criteria.

Board of Trustees

The Nebraska State College System Board of Trustees provides four-year, full-tuition waivers to Nebraska high school graduates with a 25 or higher ACT score (1200 SAT). Waivers are awarded on a competitive basis, so apply early.



Financing Your Education

Financial aid is available for students who need additional resources to help pay for college expenses. To apply for federal financial aid, a single application is all you need — the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA determines your eligibility for grants, loans, and work study funds. You must complete the FAFSA every year to be considered for aid.

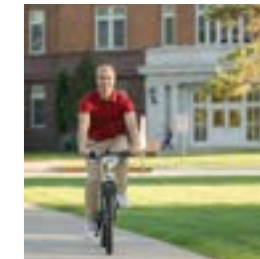

Applying is Easy

Applying to CSC is quick and easy, so apply! You'll be glad you did — both now and after you graduate.

- Apply online for free at csc.edu/admissions. There is no application fee.
- Send your official high school transcript that includes courses taken and grades received so far.
- Send your official ACT or SAT scores. We use these to consider you for academic scholarships and placement into the correct college courses. CSC's ACT school code is **2466** and SAT school code is **6466**.

Being accepted is also easy. New freshmen just need to have graduated from an accredited high school and then — congratulations, you're in!

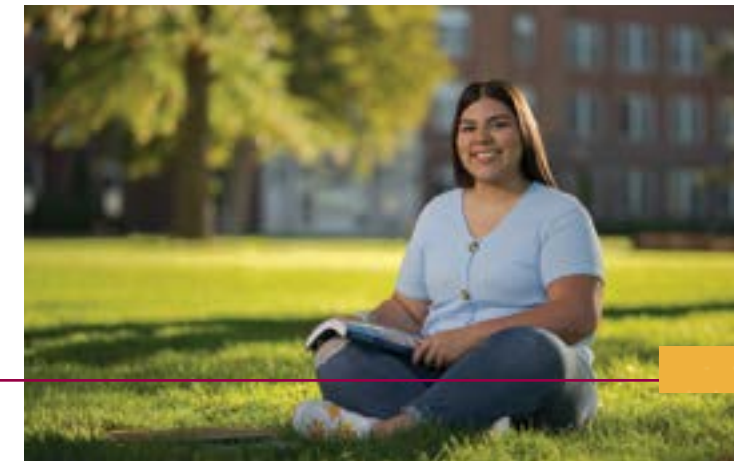
