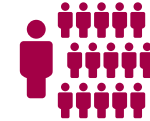

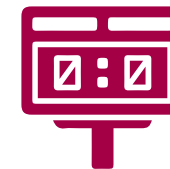

How to Apply

Applying to Chadron State College is an effortless process that you can complete in three steps:

1. Apply now



2. Submit Transcripts

If you have taken 12 or more college-level credits after high school graduation, you are not required to submit a high school transcript. If you have not taken 12 or more college-level credits, then send an official certified copy of your high school transcript to one of the companies below to be evaluated.

CSC requires official certified copies of your college transcripts be sent from all the colleges you have attended since graduating from high school.

College transcripts from international colleges must be evaluated through one of the companies listed below. Transcripts should be sent directly from the evaluating company to Chadron State College at international@csc.edu.

3. English Proficiency

International applicants whose first language is English are not required to provide additional English proficiency results.

International applicants whose first language is not English must provide evidence of English proficiency. Applicants must provide one of the following: TOEFL, IELTS, DUOLINGO, SAT or ACT.

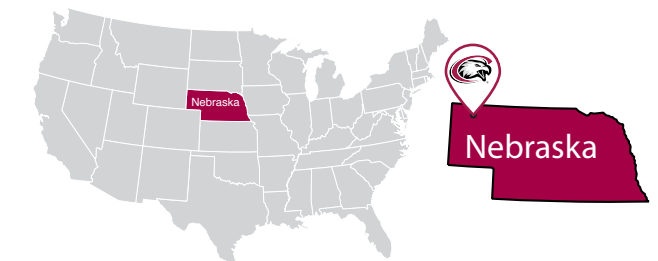


Where We Are

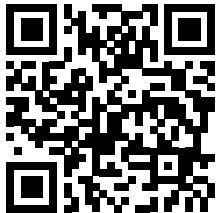
