Dr. Lisa Tatum, Honor Band Conductor

Dr. Lisa Tatum enjoys a career of making music in diverse settings. Whether on a football field, concert hall, or theater, she believes that all music has the power to inspire and bring people together. She completed a Doctor of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting at Texas Tech University in May 2023. In 2020, she completed a Master of Music in Wind Conducting at Louisiana State University. She also holds a Master of Music in Trombone Performance from the University of Utah and a Bachelor of Science in Music Education from the University of Alabama. Before joining the faculty at Lubbock Christian University in 2022, Dr. Tatum taught middle school and high school band in Houston, TX. She is an active clinician and adjudicator for high school bands across the country and hosts the podcast *IC2us: The Evolving Conductor*. She co-founded the West Texas Youth Winds in 2024, a community band that serves high school band students in the South Plains.

Dr. Joel Schreuder, Honor Choir Conductor

Dr. Joel Schreuder is a Professor of Music and the Director of Choral Activities at Chadron State College in Chadron, Nebraska. His teaching duties at Chadron State include conducting the Concert Choir, Community Chorus, Vocal Jazz Ensemble, teaching music history, conducting, choral education classes, and private voice lessons. Dr. Schreuder is in demand as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator in Nebraska and the High Plains region. Since his arrival at CSC in 2002, Dr. Schreuder has directed the High Plains Choir Festival as well as several district music festivals and honor choirs in Nebraska, Wyoming, South Dakota, Montana, and Colorado, and has served 3 years as the artistic director for the Gillette Chamber Singers. His international conducting and performing experience includes concerts, tours, and conferences in China, Germany, and Ukraine. Dr. Schreuder, a native of Portland, Oregon, received his Doctor of Musical Arts in Choral Conducting from Arizona State University, his Master of Arts in Conducting from Washington State University, and his Bachelor of Arts in Music Education from Pacific Lutheran University.

Mr. Jeremy Quick, Honor Guitar Ensemble

Jeremy Quick, a musician and composer, has been studying and enjoying music since he was a young child. Quick was born in Massachusetts and raised in northwest Montana. In 2003, he moved to Boston, where he continued his musical education, enrolling in Berklee College of Music. Soon thereafter, Jeremy elected to forego traditional classwork for a more self-motivated form of study. Since then, he's been performing live: nationally and internationally, solo and with groups. From 2008 to 2014, Jeremy was the chairman of the guitar department at North Andover Music Academy (Andover, MA).

In 2021, Quick completed a master's degree in jazz studies at the University of Northern Colorado. He is now a faculty member at Chadron State College in Nebraska where he teaches coursework in the Music Industry option as well as guitar and bass lessons.
